The main objective of this virtual conference was to showcase how to incorporate ethical values in curriculum designing and aimed to identify approaches to teaching ethics. The conference attempted as a novel venture to initiate and invite innovative observations and thought-provoking discussions on development of the total personality of the individual.

The International Conference began with the keynote address by R. Limbadri, Chairman, Telangana State Council of Higher Education followed by a presentation on Ethical Foundations of Global Partnerships by Ms. Christine Housel from Geneva with three technical sessions by Ms. Karuna Rajan Satardekar, Dr. Joseph Dunston and Dr. John Methuselah. Principal Dr. Sr. Sandra Horta gave Presidential Address highlighting the need and objective of the conference. Ms. Deepa James, Head, Department of Commerce, St. Francis College for Women, acquainted us with the Genesis of the conference.

The conference witnessed an energetic participation from 5 different countries like Nepal, Switzerland, gulf countries and India. Around 729 participants joined through Zoom platform and around 1500 people watched live on SFC YouTube channel.

41st Graduation Ceremony 2021

St. Francis College for Women held its 41st Convocation ceremony for 1319 students of PG 2019-2021 PG and UG 2018-2021 batches on Saturday, 27th November 2021. The ceremony was held in the Indoor Stadium and was graced by the honourable Vice-Chancellor, Osmania University, Prof. D. Ravinder and the honourable Mayor, GHMC, Hyderabad Smt. Gadwal Vijayalakshmi.

The college presented 53 Gold medals and 1148 UG and 171 PG degrees during the convocation. The Convocation began with the welcome address by Dr. Sr. Sandra Horta, Principal of the College, followed by a talk by Smt. Gadwal Vijayalakshmi. She stressed that youth have a great role to play in nation building and development. The students felt motivated with her insights. Prof. D. Activities & Sessions

The Investiture Ceremony of CCGP for all the 16 student ambassadors was held on August 25, 2021 and the orientation for students was held on 27th September -2021

Webinar on “A Talk on Civil Services as a Career option” was held on July 23, 2021, from 3 pm to 4:30pm via Zoom . The guest speaker was Dr. Neha Agarwal who is a founder partner at Gargi Knowledge Solutions. Alumnus of St. Francis College. She is a trained and Advance level certified career counsellor from Career Development Agency, USA. A total of 170 students participated in this webinar.

Webinar on MBA in India and Abroad & Importance of GMAT was conducted on August 12, 2021, from 4 pm to 5 pm. The speaker of the session was Ms. Sowmya Gupta - Chief Executive Officer at Jamboree. 110 UG & PG students had participated.

Webinar on Career Guidance Program “Ask Me Anything” was held on August 21, 2021, from 9 am to 10:30 am via WebEx platform in collaboration with ‘The Guiding Voice’. **90 students** had participated. The speakers for this were Naveen Samala, Janaki Kambhupati.

Webinar on Career Orientation, ‘At the Crossroads’ was held on August 31st- 2021, in collaboration with Mr. Laxmikant Sharma, Founder & CEO, Forms Kat. The goal of the webinar was to help participants gain a better awareness of educational and professional prospects and options, so as to make more meaningful and informed career decisions. It included 3 sessions. The session 1 on Higher Education was covered by Dr. Jai Raj Nair. The Session 2 focused on ‘Corporate Skills’ by Mr. Prakash Pathak discussing on the Do's and Don'ts of interviews, as well as how to prepare a C.V. The final session was conducted by Mr.

The main objective was to make students analyse themselves and to make known to them their strengths and weaknesses. The speakers for CAMP were Mr. Naqi Abbas and Mr. Bhaskar Sharma the co- founders of Enable Careers. CAMP was spread across two days. This was attended by 400 students.

Webinar on Building a Winning Profile was held on November 3, 2021, from 12 pm to 1:30 pm via Cisco WebEx video conferencing platform. The speaker for this session was (an alumnus from St. Francis College) Ms. Nishitha Ajaykumar Senior Specialist - Human Capital Team from DE Shaw. A total of 120 students were a part of this event.

Placements began on November 1, 2021, with D.E. Shaw being the first company followed by Arcesium, Goldman Sachs, Deloitte, etc. The pay package offered were in the range of Rs. 3 lakhs to Rs. 23 lakhs.
