

GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDELINES

ADMISSION PROCESS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-23

The Department of Management Studies commends the 100 students who have qualified for this round of the admission process.

Please read the following instructions carefully.

1. The Group Discussion Round is scheduled for the **6th July, 2022**.
2. Each Group Discussion session will have 10 candidates, which means that the 100 candidates will be divided into 10 groups of 10 candidates each.
3. Each Team of 10 will report as per the time allotted. Not reporting on time will lead to disqualification.

PREPARING FOR THE GD

1. The candidates will be given the topic upon joining the session. Once the topic is given, all candidates have 2 minutes to prepare. We recommend that you keep a notepad and pen handy for this purpose.
2. The entire Group Discussion session will take place in three rounds:

Round One:

Each candidate is given 45 seconds to give opening comments on the topic given.

Round Two:

All candidates will discuss each other's opinions and comments and discuss among themselves. This round will last for 5 minutes.

Round Three:

Each candidate will be given 1 minute to give her closing comments.

3. The topics for the Group Discussion will be of a general nature and are meant to test a candidate's:
 - a. Clarity of thought and speech
 - b. Confidence
 - c. Presence of mind
4. Candidates are expected to conduct themselves with dignity, raising the voice and/or the use of rough and offensive language will lead to the candidate being disqualified.

5. At no point in time during the entire session, is the candidate allowed to ask any queries to the moderators of the session.
6. The candidates will be observed by a panel of judges and the entire session will be coordinated by a Moderator.
7. The candidates are not allowed to engage with either the Panel or the Moderator under any circumstances.
